

[EPEAT] Criterion 6.4.1 Optional – Manufacturer program for reduction of high priority process chemicals

Getac values safe and healthy work environment, exceeding industry standards through our Process Chemicals Management Specification. Our in-scope facilities are certified to ISO 45001 and RBA standards, demonstrating robust systems for worker safety and health.

We defines high priority process chemicals as those that listed on the Clean Electronics Production Network (CEPN) Priority Chemicals List, hereinafter “the CEPN List”. As of 13 March 2026, the CEPN list has 25 Priority Chemicals. Please refer to CEPN website at <https://cleanelectronicsproduction.org/tools-resources/priority-chemicals> for details.

For the 2025 reporting year, our in-scope facilities confirmed no use of any high priority process chemical in product manufacturing. We annually collect process chemical inventory from all facilities to identify high priority process chemical. Any identified high priority process chemical is required to be eliminated within 3 years, and Getac works closely with facilities to ensure a smooth phase-out—creating a safer and healthier work environment.
