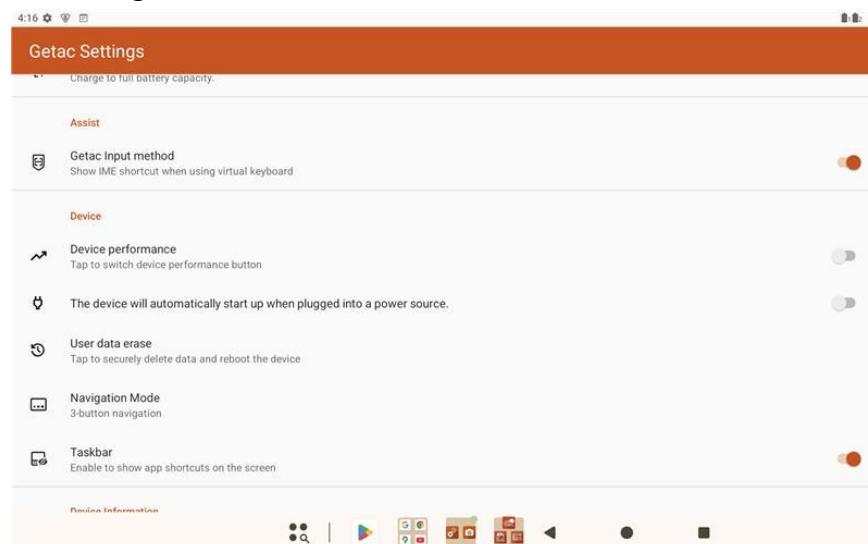

What is Getac Secure Erase?

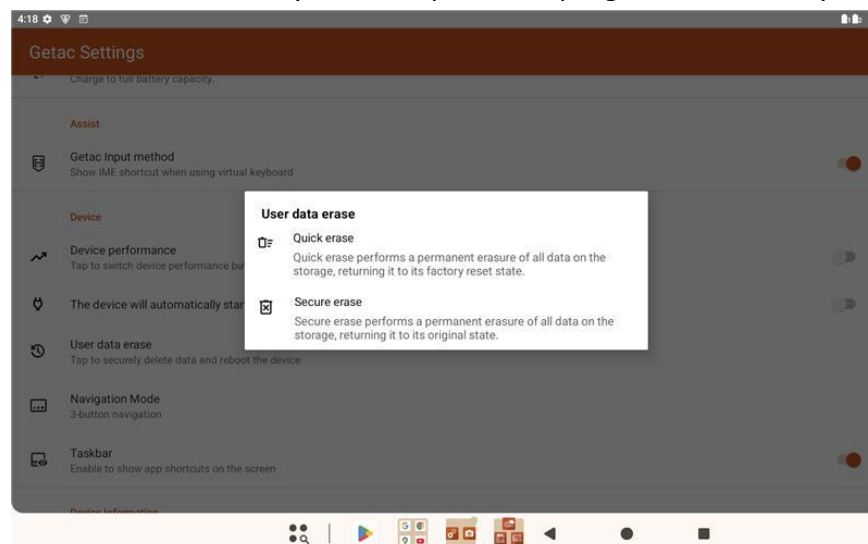
Getac Secure Erase is a data sanitization method integrated into the Getac Settings applications for our Android devices. The feature is designed to permanently remove all stored data from storage devices, including all UFS storages used in our products, ensuring that the erased information is unrecoverable and irretrievable. The method adheres to industry standard NIST SP 800-88 “clear” and “purge” for secure data deletion, safeguarding the data assets of Getac’s valued customers. Please note that the operation is irreversible, and it is essential to back up any necessary data before proceeding.

Instructions

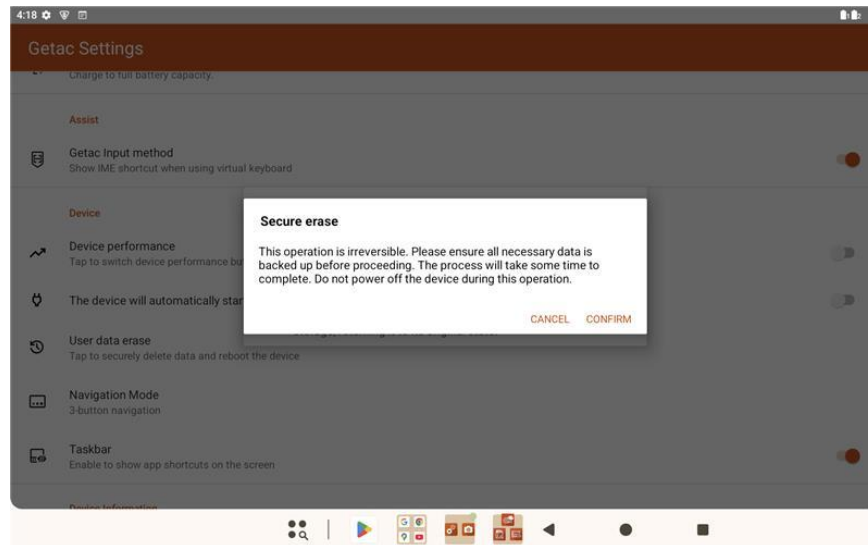
1. Open Getac Settings and click on “User data erase”.



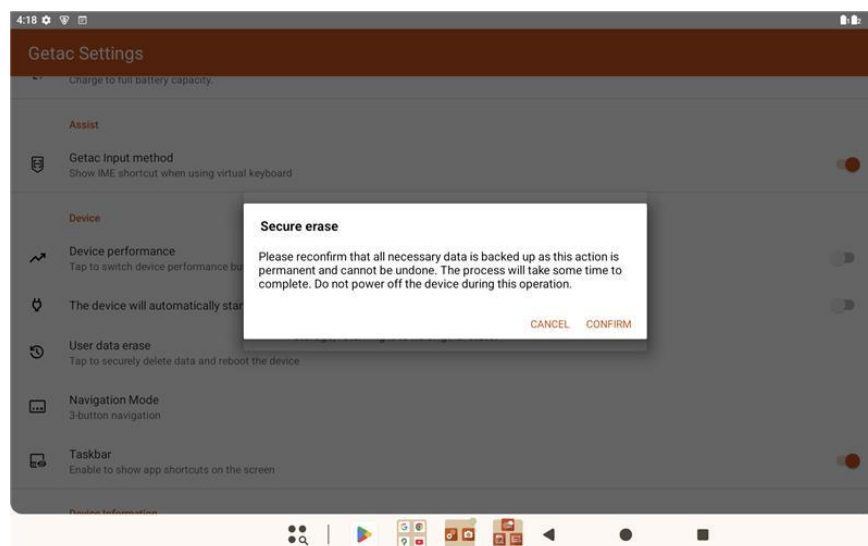
2. Select “Secure erase” in order to perform the data erasure adhering to the NIST SP 800-88 methods. When available, system will perform “purge” automatically.



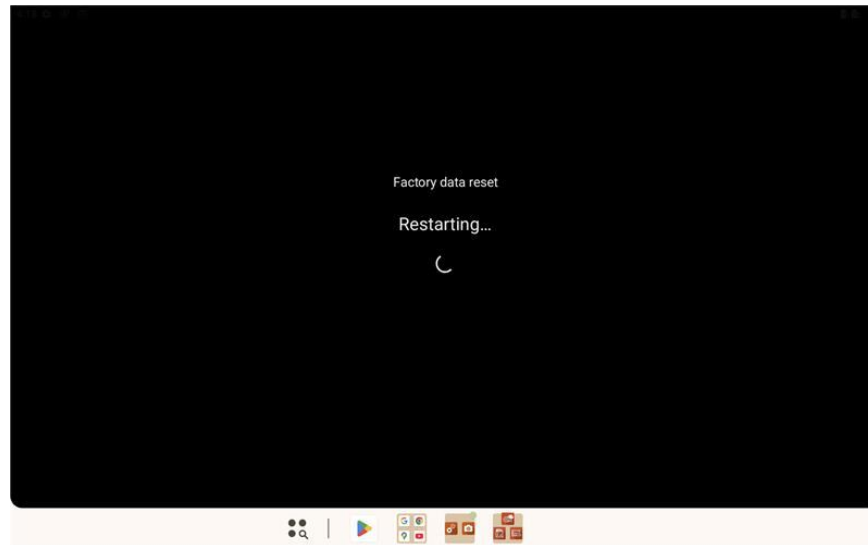
- Click on “CONFIRM” to perform “Secure erase”. Please ensure all necessary data is backed up before proceeding.



- Please click on “CONFIRM” a second time to avoid accidental activation.



5. Factory data is being reset. It may take a while for the system to restart.



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
